

# Hurricane Katrina Project

Services available through September 28, 2007

## Eligible Participants

- Hurricane Katrina Evacuees
- At least 18 years old
- Displaced from their jobs and their home state of Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, or Texas
- Includes those who are long-term unemployed or without work experience
- Must either be temporarily or permanently residing in NC

## Activities

- Classroom training  
*Assists with skills upgrading. Covers tuition, books, supplies, etc.*
- On-the-job training  
*Opportunity to learn new job skills while working. Only available for those who plan to permanently locate in NC.*
- Needs related payments  
*Covers other costs such as transportation, childcare, food, clothing, for those who are enrolled in training. Only available to those evacuees who are not otherwise eligible to receive regular unemployment insurance benefits, disaster unemployment insurance, or have exhausted these benefits.*
- Public Sector Employment  
*Offers temporary employment in the public sector.*
